EPA Farmer to Farmer Grant

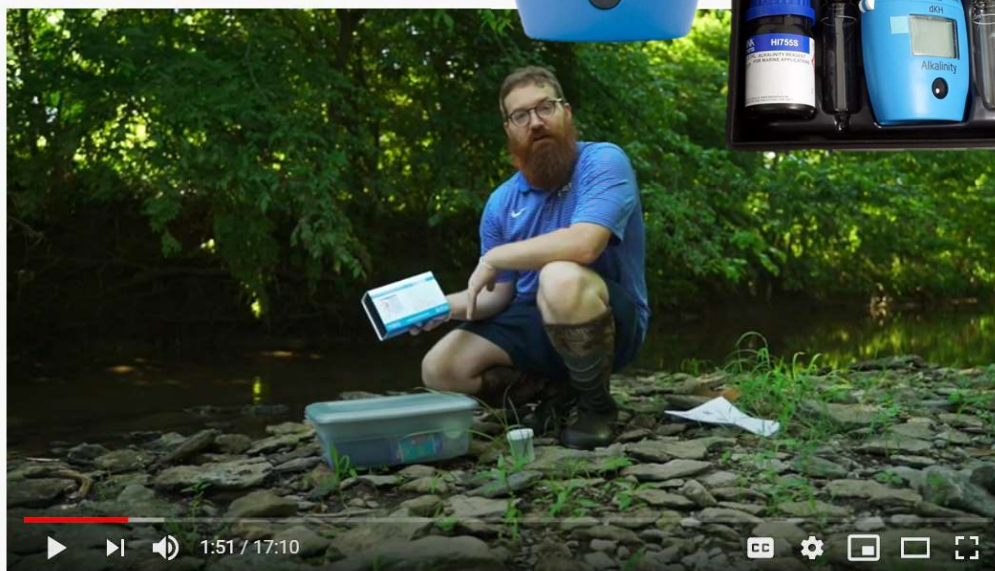
- Farmer-led & farmer-focused
