








## **Residential Buildings**

- Existing building retrofits
- Solar PV Systems on 50% of homes



#### **Energy Industry**

- 70% reduction in energy generation intensity factor
- LEDs in lighting fixtures and streetlights



#### **Commercial Buildings**

- Renewable natural gas in 20% of buildings
- Solar PV Systems on 25% of buildings



#### **Transportation**

- Fuel switching
- Active transportation and ridesharing



## Manufacturing Industries and Construction

- Deep energy retrofits
- Fuel switch to natural gas



#### Waste

- Organic waste diversion programs
- Methane recovery at landfills and wastewater treatment plants

## Preparing Louisville for Climate Change Impacts


- Heat-related fatalities
- Increased cost of energy
- Increasing violence and crime
- Loss of affordability and housing opportunities
- Worsening inequities around gentrification, race, and income
- Worsening traffic congestion
- Declining air quality
- Increased food insecurity

## An Opportunity for Equity

Climate change will not impact everyone equally!

Resilience strategies must not simply address climate change vulnerabilities, but **the intersecting factors** that make populations more vulnerable.


Strategies that do not **actively address** historical inequities will, in fact, **actively worsen** those inequities.




# Louisville Metro Sustainability Programs

## Cool Roof Rebate Program

Install an ENERGY STAR reflective roof on your property and receive a \$1/ft<sup>2</sup> rebate








Save 7-15% on cooling costs and help the city manage urban heat!

Cool Roof Rebate Program

Targeted High-Heat Districts receive 70% of funding



## Energy Project Assessment District (EPAD) Program



Nationally known as PACE





Financing mechanism to repay private loans for energy efficiency, renewable energy, and water conservation projects



Available to commercial, agricultural, industrial, and multi-family property owners



Loan provides up to 100% of the project's cost and requires no down payment **Bike Sense Louisville** is a public art project centered around bicycle use in Louisville.

Temperature, air-quality and location data is being collected from volunteer cyclists around the city, using small sensor units that attach to bicycles. The data is being interpreted into sound in real-time and playing on a pedestrian bridge.

With this health and cycling information, Louisville Metro can make important changes to bike paths and routes.
